Directions from downtown via Trax:

1. Take the Redline eastbound (Medical Center) and descend at the Fort Douglas stop.
2. Cross the Legacy Bridge and follow the footpath toward the mountains until you reach Fort Douglas Blvd.
3. Turn right onto Fort Douglas Blvd and walk to the third intersection which is De Trobriand Street
4. The Environmental Humanities office is the building on the corner, #618A De Trobriand Street.

Driving directions from downtown:

1. Take East University Blvd (400 South Street) from downtown east to Mario Capecchi Drive.
2. At the intersection, turn left onto Mario Capecchi Drive.
3. At the first intersection with the stoplight, South Campus Drive, turn right onto Hempstead Road into Fort Douglas.
4. Follow Hempstead Road east to Fort Douglas Blvd.
5. Bear left onto Fort Douglas Blvd.
6. At the intersection of Fort Douglas Blvd and De Trobriand Street, turn left. The Environmental Humanities office is the first building on the right, #618A De Trobriand Street.

Driving directions from I-215 Northbound:

1. Exit the I-215 belt route at Foothill Drive. Continue heading north on Foothill Drive, approximately 4 miles, until you reach Mario Capecchi Drive which will be on the right.
2. Bear right onto Mario Capecchi Drive and continue to the first intersection at the stoplight which is South Campus Drive.
3. Turn right onto Hempstead Road and into the Fort Douglas. Follow Hempstead Road east to Fort Douglas Blvd.
4. Bear left onto Fort Douglas Blvd.
5. At the intersection of Fort Douglas Blvd and De Trobriand Street, turn left. The Environmental Humanities office is the first building on the right, #618A De Trobriand Street.

Driving directions from the South on I-15:

1. Exit I-15 at 600 South and continue on 600 South to 700 East.
2. Turn left onto 700 East and continue to East University Blvd (400 South).
3. Turn right onto University Blvd and follow the road to Mario Capecchi Drive.
4. At the intersection, turn left onto Mario Capecchi Drive.
5. At the first intersection with the stoplight, South Campus Drive, turn right onto Hempstead Road into Fort Douglas.
6. Follow Hempstead Road east to Fort Douglas Blvd.
7. Bear left onto Fort Douglas Blvd.
8. At the intersection of Fort Douglas Blvd and De Trobriand Street, turn left. The Environmental Humanities office is the first building on the right, #618A De Trobriand Street.

Parking:

- There are several visitor parking places on De Trobriand Street just past the Environmental Humanities building.
- Additional parking places can be found if you continue just past the intersection of Fort Douglas Blvd and De Trobriand Street. Take the first left and there are 2 hour visitor parking places on the right.
